IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Appointing a Commission on Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. The President of the Senate shall appoint two members of the Senate and the Speaker of the House shall appoint three members of the House to be known as a Commission on the Revision of Laws Relating to Taxation; such commissioners shall serve without pay, but shall be reimbursed for their actuał expenses incurred while engaged in the duties of such commission; they shall meet as soon as convenient after their appointment at such place as they select and shall choose one of their members to be Chairman and they may employ a competent clerk. Such Commission shall study and consider the laws relating to taxation and, with the assistance of the Revisor of Statutes, shall prepare such legislation as they may deem advisable for consolidating, revising and amending all laws relating to taxation in the state and the method of assessment and collection thereof.

Sec. 2. Such Commission shall, on or before Jan. 1, 1935, make a written report to the Governor and Council, which report shall be transmitted to the Clerk of the House of Representatives on the organization of the 87th Legislature and shall include such recommendation for legislation as

the Committee shall adopt with the draft for such legislation as may be suggested.

Sec. 3. The sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) is hereby appropriated for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act.
