RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Big Jim Pond Inlets.

Fishing in Big Jim Pond Inlets regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to close North East and North West Inlets to Big Jim Pond in Jim Pond Town, Franklin county, to fly fishing only with a daily limit of ten fish per person under the rules and regulations of the department.
