IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED
AND THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Exemption of Certain Property from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain property not exempted from taxation. Paragraph III of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes of 1930 is hereby amended by inserting at the end of said paragraph the following sentence:

'Provided, however, that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to a summer camp, or other seasonal resort, which receives compensation for food, or lodging or use of its facilities.'
