RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Big Jim Pond.

Fishing in Big Jim Pond regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to make the legal length of salmon that may be killed in Big Jim Pond in Jim Pond Town in Franklin county, 14 inches, under rules and regulations of the department.
