S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Quebec Extension Railway Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. **Charter of Quebec Extension Railway extended.** The rights, powers and privileges of the Quebec Extension Railway Company, which were granted by chapter 41 of the private and special laws of 1913, and extended by chapter 56 of the private and special laws of 1915, and extended by chapter 15 of the private and special laws of 1917, and extended by chapter 6 of the private and special laws of 1919, and extended by chapter 12 of the private and special laws of 1921, and extended by chapter 20 of the private and special laws of 1923, and extended by chapter 15 of the private and special laws of 1925, and extended by chapter 129 of the private and special laws of 1927, and extended by chapter 1 of the private and special laws of 1929, and extended by chapter 10 of the private and special laws of 1931, are hereby continued in force and extended for 2 years from the time this act goes into effect, and all the rights, powers, privileges and franchises which were granted or have been acquired by virtue of said act, may, and shall be exercised in the same manner and for the same purpose as provided in said chapter 41 except as hereinafter provided.

Sec. 2. **Exceptions.** Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal, or

shall be construed as repealing, the whole or any part of any existing statute, and all the rights and duties herein mentioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance with all the applicable provisions of chapter 62 of the revised statutes and all acts amendatory thereof or additional thereto.
