RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in McCoslin Brook and Turtle Pond  
Brook.

---

**McCoslin Brook and Turtle Pond Brook, opened to fishing.** Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to open to fishing under the general law McCoslin Brook and Turtle Pond Brook, both tributaries of Wight's Pond, in Penobscot, under the rules and regulations of the department.
