RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing in Webber Pond and Three Mile Pond.

Ice fishing in Webber and Three Mile ponds regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation allowing ice fishing on Saturday and Sunday of each week during February and March of each year, in the waters of Webber Pond, in the town of Vassalboro, and in the waters of Three Mile Pond, in the towns of China, Windsor and Vassalboro, in the county of Kennebec.
