RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Noyes Pond.

Fishing in Noyes Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to ice fishing, Noyes Pond, so-called, in the town of Bluehill; and limiting the number of fish taken in open season to ten fish to any one person in any one day.
