RESOLVE, Relating to Taking of Smelts in Webb's Pond.

Taking of smelts in Webb's Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation that it shall be unlawful to take smelts, except an amount not to exceed 1 quart of smelts per family per day may be taken during the hours between sunrise and sunset, for bait purposes only, in Webb's Pond, or Weld Pond, so-called, and its tributaries.
