RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Sandy Stream in Penobscot County.

Sandy Stream closed to fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing that part of Sandy Stream in Penobscot county below the mouth of Togue Stream.
