RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Great Pond in Belgrade Chain of Lakes.

Opening Great Pond to pickerel and pike fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Great Pond in the Belgrade Chain of Lakes to pickerel and pike fishing under the general law.
