RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Pleasant Pond in the Town of Turner.

Size and bag limit regulated in Pleasant Pond. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing at 10 inches the legal length of trout and at 12 inches the legal length of salmon and 15 pounds or 15 fish as the bag limit for fish taken in Pleasant Pond in the town of Turner.
