RESOLVE, Regulating Smelt Fishing in Crooked and Songo Rivers.

Smelt fishing in Crooked and Songo rivers regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting smelts to be taken during April and May of each year in Crooked and Songo rivers, in Cumberland county; with a limit of 10 quarts per family each year.
