IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT Relating to University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 19, § 117, amended. Section 117 of c. 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 117. Mill tax to be assessed to support University of Maine. A tax of $\frac{2}{3}$ of 1 mill on a dollar shall annually be assessed upon all the property in the state according to the valuation thereof and shall be known as the mill tax for the support of the University of Maine.'
