STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Bounty on Porcupines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Bounty on porcupines provided for. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 249 of the public laws of 1931, there shall be paid to the several cities and towns of the state such sum or sums of money as may be due such cities and towns under the provisions of section 78 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes; the disbursement of such funds to be charged against money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
