AN ACT Authorizing Suspension of State Normal Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Suspension of state normal schools authorized. The department of education is hereby authorized and empowered to suspend for a period not exceeding two years, not more than three of the state normal schools, to be determined by the commissioner of education, when in his opinion such suspension may be necessary and will not lower the educational standards of the state.
