IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT Relating to Trapping in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Trapping season in Aroostook county regulated. It shall be lawful to trap fur-bearing animals within the county of Aroostook from November 1st of each year to February 15th of the following year, both days inclusive. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
