S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT Relating to Town, City and Village By-laws and Ordinances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 5, § 136, sub § XIV, amended. Sub-section XIV of section 136 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes as amended is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'For regulating and controlling the business of hawking and peddling of goods, wares and merchandise within their limits, for the issuing by their municipal officers of municipal licenses and the imposing of license fees therefor.

This paragraph shall not apply to commercial agents or other persons selling by samples, lists, catalogues or otherwise, goods, wares or merchandise for future delivery, ~~persons, selling fish, farm, dairy or orchard products; and persons selling bark, wood or forest products,~~ and persons selling newspapers or religious literature.'
