AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Brunswick to Use Party Designations
on Ballots for Town Meetings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Brunswick may use party designations on ballots. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 44 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes the municipal officers of the town of Brunswick may in the preparation of ballots for town meetings, list the candidates by parties and under a party designation, the separate party lists to be arranged as required by said section alphabetically according to surnames.
