STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the School Board of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. **School committee appointed by mayor.** Section I of c. 465 of the private and special laws of 1868 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 7. The city council of Lewiston may elect a superintending school committee, of not less than seven nor more than twenty one members, or may provide for the election of the same by the legal voters in the several wards of said city of Lewiston; and may also determine their terms of service and compensations; The superintending school committee of Lewiston shall consist of the mayor, ex officio, and 4 members, 2 of which shall represent each of the 2 major political parties and shall be appointed by the mayor for terms of 4 years each; provided, that in case a superintendent of schools is appointed, as authorized by this act, then the superintending school committee shall receive no compensation.

- Sec. 2. Original members appointed as provided in § I shall hold office for I, 2, 3 and 4 years respectively and vacancies in said board shall be filled by appointment, as provided in § I for the unexpired term.
 - Sec. 3. Effective date. This act shall take effect ?
