STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Town Council and Manager Form of Government for the Town of Presque Isle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L. 1931, c. 100, § 2, amended. The first paragraph of § 2 of c. 100 of the P. & S. L. of 1931 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Election of officers. At such meetings, the voters shall choose by ballot, as hereinafter provided, 5 inhabitants of said town to be known as councillors, a town clerk, an auditor of accounts, and a member of the superintending school committee. The councillors shall select annually a town treasurer and a tax collector; and once in 3 years a health officer, subject to the approval of the state commissioner of health as now provided by general law; and when a vacancy exists, shall select a town manager, with the duties hereinafter defined, for a term not to exceed 3 years. Except as hereinafter provided, all other necessary town officers provided by this act or now or hereafter provided under any statute or by-law shall be appointed by the town manager subject to approval by a majority of the council.'
