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RESOLVE, Authorizing the Commissioner of Health and Welfare to  
Convey and Acquire Property.

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**Sale of realty of school for the deaf authorized.** Resolved: That the commissioner of health and welfare be, and hereby is, authorized, to convey the interest of the state in the real and personal property used in connection with the school for the deaf, subject to the approval of the governor and council, and in exchange therefor, or after any such sale for cash, to acquire other and different real and personal property in place thereof, subject to the same approval and within the limits of the city of Portland.
