STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Smelts in the Brooks of Steuben, Milbridge, Cherryfield, Harrington, Addison, Columbia and Jonesboro.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Regulating smelt fishing in certain towns in Washington County. It shall be lawful to catch smelts with the hands for table use only in the family of the person catching the smelts, said smelts not to be caught and sold, in the brooks of Steuben, Milbridge, Cherryfield, Harrington, Addison, Columbia and Jonesboro, during the months of April and May of each year.
