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A N   A C T   R e l a t i n g   t o   P r e p a y m e n t   o f   T a x e s .

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**Towns may permit prepayment of taxes and pay interest thereon.** Chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered Par. 65-A and to read as follows :

**'Sec. 65-A. Prepayment of taxes; interest paid thereon.** Towns at any properly called meeting may authorize their collectors or treasurers to accept prepayment of taxes not yet due or assessed and to pay thereon interest at not exceeding the rate of ten percent. Any excess paid in over the amount finally assessed shall be repaid, with the interest due on the whole transaction, at the date that the tax finally assessed is due and payable.'
