STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Blakslee Lake.

Fishing in Blakslee lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to close to trout and salmon fishing, Blakslee lake in township 5, range 6, B. K. P. W. K. R., except by fly fishing or trolling, and to prohibit taking more than 10 such fish in any one day, or more than 5 pounds of such fish unless the last fish taken increases the combined weight thereof to more than 5 pounds, under the rules and regulations of the department.
