IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in George Durgin Pond.

Fishing in George Durgin pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to open to fly fishing under the general law, George Durgin pond, in Somerset county, and to prohibit taking more than 5 pounds of trout and salmon in any one day per person, under the rules and regulations of the department.
