RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Butler and Deer Ponds.

Fishing in Butler and Deer ponds regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Deer and Butler Ponds in T 4 R 5, Somerset county to all fishing except by the ordinary way of fly fishing with a daily limit of 10 fish per person.
