STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT To Extend the Provisions of the Absent Voting Law to Towns Using the Australian Ballot.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Absent voting law to apply to towns using the Australian Ballot. All the provisions of chapter 9 of the revised statutes insofar as the same may be applicable shall apply to elections in towns which conduct their elections under the provisions of sections 38 to 52 inclusive of chapter 5 of the revised statutes.
