Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Entrance to Aziscohos Lake designated. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game is authorized and directed to place 2 red posts on opposite banks of the Little Magalloway River at the point where said river enters into Aziscohos Lake, said posts to be set at the high water mark of Aziscohos Lake.
