IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT Relative to the Hunting of Foxes in the Counties of Cumberland,
Androscoggin and Oxford.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Open season on foxes in certain counties. There shall be an open season on foxes in the counties of Cumberland, Androscoggin and Oxford from the first day of November to the first day of March following, during which time it shall be unlawful to take foxes in any other manner than by hunting with dog and gun.
