AN ACT Relating to Smelt Fishing in Town of Turner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Smelt fishing in Turner regulated. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting smelts to be taken with a dip net for the purpose of food in the town of Turner.
