AN ACT Relating to Ice Fishing in Aroostook County.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Ice Fishing in town of Morrill regulated.** The commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed under the rules and regulations of the department, to open to ice fishing under the general law Bear Mountain pond, Bradford pond, Green pond, Hale pond, Tote Road pond, Mud lake, Rocabena lake and Pleasant lake.
