## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting of Moose.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Moose may be hunted in Penobscot county. The 1st paragraph of § 60 of c. 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 60. Hunting and importation of moose and caribou regulated. No person shall hunt or have in his possession any caribou or moose, or parts thereof, except that from November 10 to November 18, both dates inclusive, moose may be hunted in the county of Penobscot.'
