AN ACT Relating to Hunting of Moose.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Moose may be hunted in Penobscot county.** The 1st paragraph of § 60 of c. 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 60. Hunting and importation of moose and caribou regulated.** No person shall hunt or have in his possession any caribou or moose, or parts thereof, **except that from November 10 to November 18, both dates inclusive, moose may be hunted in the county of Penobscot.'**
