RESOLVE, Regulating the Taking of Muskrats on Massacre Pond in
Scarboro.

Muskrat hunting on Massacre pond regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Massacre Pond in Scarborough for the taking of muskrats for a period of 5 years.
