RESOLVE, Relating to Catching of Trout in Certain Waters.

Catching of Trout in Certain Waters, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation that no trout less than 8 inches in length shall be caught and killed in the waters of Johnson Mt. Town, upper Cold Stream tract, Parlin Pond Town and Misery Town.
