RESOLVE, Relating to Ice Fishing in Long Pond.

Ice Fishing in Long Pond regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to ice fishing, under the general law, Long Pond in Somerville, and Jefferson and Windsor.
