IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Stanley Pond.

Fishing in Stanley Pond regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation limiting the length of salmon taken from Stanley pond in the towns of Hiram and Porter to not less than 14 inches.
