AN ACT Providing for Removal of Paupers to Town of Settlement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 33, amended. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting therein a new section to follow section 31 and to be numbered section 31-A.

‘Sec. 31-A. **Removal of paupers to town of settlement.** Upon receipt of the notice required under the provisions of section 31 the overseers of a town wherein a pauper who is the subject of that notice has his settlement shall cause said pauper to be removed and taken to his place of settlement with reasonable promptness and in default of such removal the town of settlement shall be holden for all expenses legitimately incurred in behalf of said pauper including his proper schooling.’
