STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Taking of Testimony.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Taking of testimony regulated. When any witness is questioned as to any statement, either oral or written, he may have made relative to the cause being tried it shall be competent for the adverse party to disclose the name of the person to whom the alleged statement was made, the name of such person's employer, if any, and any facts tending to show bias, prejudice or interest on the part of such person.
