AN ACT Relative to Sunday Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 44 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 44. **Sunday hunting.** Sunday is a closed season, on which it is not lawful to hunt any wild animals or wild birds of any kind, **excepting any Sunday which falls within the dates when it is lawful to hunt partridge, duck or deer.**'
