AN ACT to Amend the Vital Statistics Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Contents of death records. Paragraph 111 of section 15 of chapter 72 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

“111. The record of death shall state its date, the full christian and surname of the deceased, the sex, color, condition, whether single or married, age, occupation, place of birth, place of death, **residence**, the full christian and surnames and birthplaces of parents, and the disease or other cause of death, so far as known, **whether or not the deceased is a veteran of any war, and term of service.**”
