AN ACT to Provide for the Care of Insane Paupers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Expenses for insane paupers regulated. The provisions of section 15 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes shall not be applicable to insane persons but all expense incident to the care of such insane persons as are in need of relief shall be borne by the town of settlement if within the state, or where an insane pauper has no pauper settlement within the state, then by the state.
