STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Construction and Maintenance of Roads Within 500 Feet of State Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Maintenance of certain ways provided for. The construction, reconstruction, improvement and maintenance of all ways within 500 feet of any state institution shall be borne wholly by the state, except where such institutions are located in towns having a population of more than 10,000 inhabitants.
