STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to the Revocation of Licenses after Violation of the Fish and Game Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, § 43, amended. Section 43 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Upon the conviction of any person holding a license issued by virtue of this chapter of any violation of the fish and game laws, said license may be revoked by the commissioner at his discretion, and no new license shall be issued for a period of 1 year thereafter to such person. For any 2nd or subsequent offense the commissioner may revoke said license for a period not to exceed 2 years. Any person whose license has been revoked, shall within 48 hours after notice thereof, return said license to the commissioner of inland fisheries and game.

‘The commissioner may refuse to issue any license provided for by this chapter for a period of 1 year after a conviction for any violation of the fish and game laws by a person not holding a proper license at the time of such violation.’
