IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-

AN ACT Relative to Dealers in Live Bait; License Therefor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, additional. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following as section 38-A.

‘Any firm or corporation who deals in live bait, catches for sale or buys for resale said bait, shall first procure a license from the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, so to do, for which license he shall pay the fee of \$2.00 annually, said license authorizes the person holding the same to use the ordinary commercial type of minnow trap or the ordinary commercial type of minnow seine not to exceed 4 feet in depth by 25 feet in length in the taking of minnows and other unprotected fish commonly used for bait purposes.’
