IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-
THREE

AN ACT Providing for Pensions for Call-Firemen in Augusta.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Call-firemen in Augusta may be pensioned. Section 4 of chapter 75 of the private and special laws of 1919, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

'Call-firemen may be pensioned. Any "call-fireman" so-called, who has served in the fire department for 30 years or more, shall be retired on a pension of \$125.00 per year.'
