STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting and Trapping Bear.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Hunting and trapping of bear regulated. It shall be lawful to hunt and trap bear at any time, anywhere, in the state of Maine. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
