STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to the Use of Power Boats in Hunting Waterfowl.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, § 59, amended. Section 59 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 59. Use of vehicles, boats, etc., in hunting wild fowl, regulated. No person shall at any time hunt from an automobile, airplane, power boat, sailboat, any boat under sail, any floating device towed by a power boat or any boat propelled by a motor attached in any manner, in hunting any sea birds, duck or waterfowl, in any inland or tidal waters of the state.'
