AN ACT Relative to Partridge or Ruffed Grouse.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, § 55, ¶ 2, amended. Paragraph 2 of section 55 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'There shall be a closed season on partridge from November ~~tenth~~ 16 to September 30 of the following year, both days inclusive, and no person shall, during the open season, have in possession in any one day more than 4 partridge, or in any one open season for partridge or ruffed grouse more than 25 of the above named birds, nor shall any person at any time buy or sell any partridge or ruffed grouse.
